
# Planning For Deployment

- Take care of your family
- Understand the Unit's mission and your role
- Communicate with down range personnel
  - What are the contractor/ethics issues?
- Review and know (in addition to Ethics):
  - Operational Law
  - Fiscal Law
  - Contracting Law
- Get out on a range



# Planning For Deployment

- General Orders
- Review OPLANS
- FRAGGOs
- LOGCAP or other support contracts
- Understand when and how you will embark into theatre
- Know your teams and investigative support
  - CID, NCIS, IG etc
  - DCAA
- Language Skills?

# Contingency Operations

- Robust Contractor Support
- LOGCAP
- Indigenous Host Nation Support
  - Armed Forces
  - Civilian Employment Programs
- Most issues are fiscal or contract
  - Ability or inability to resolve contract  
Issues may lead to ethics issues



# Contingency Operations

- Ethics and Standards of Conduct Exceptions
  - Combat Zone Extension to File Financial Disclosure Reports
  - NO OTHERS!
- It was important ...
- Had to do it ....
- Everyone else was doing it ....  
All are excuses told to investigators!

# Contractor Conduct


- Contractor Personnel are not the Commander's Personnel

- Task Orders

- Badging/CAC
- Life Support and Access
- Weapons
- Motor Vehicles

- Local Support Contractors
