MEMORANDUM FOR DIRECTOR, DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY

SUBJECT: Iraqi National Congress' Intelligence Collection Program

At the July 25, 2002 Deputies lunch, we discussed the Intelligence Collection Program (ICP) run by the Iraqi National Congress (INC) and decided that DIA should administer the ICP. We also decided that the funding of the ICP should come from the Intelligence Community.

I request that DIA develop a concept of operations for administering the ICP. The program should focus on defector debriefings (with INC, [REDACTED] and DIA participation), and a process for efficient dissemination of intelligence.

Maintaining this program is a high priority for the Department of Defense.
